

## Practice Guidelines:

- \* Waivers will need to be signed by each player's parent/guardian, before practice or games can begin.
- \* There shall be no more than 10 persons present per field.
- \* Practices will be one hour long twice weekly, and will be staggered with 15 minute intervals. This will help minimize people at the field, and account for coming and going. Designated entrances will be assigned depending on field used for practice.
- \* Coaches will be responsible for communicating information to parents about schedules, rules and entrances.
- \* Practices will consist of 8 kids and 2 coaches. And be separated by ages
- \* We will be using two fields to start, moving into using all four fields once routines, schedules and safety measures are set.
- \* Parents **will not be allowed** to watch practices from within ball field. They may watch from cars or outside of fence.
- \* Be on time, if you are early please wait in your car until previous practices have exited facility. This also goes for pick-up as well, **do not be late!**
- \* Equipment and water bottles must be brought in by each kid, no shared equipment. Water fountain **will not** be turned on. Bathrooms **will be closed** during practice. Please have your child go before arriving at the field.
- \* Helmets will be available for purchase, or to borrow. If you do not have one for your child let us know.
- \* No seeds, gum, spitting, licking fingers etc will be allowed this year. We need to restrict droplet spread.

- \* Equipment will need to be wiped down post practice. Wipes and hand sanitizer will be provided in each dugout. If parents would like to provide their children with their own, that is also acceptable.
- \* Dugouts should be used as minimally as possible, if **not at all** during practice.
- \* Kids can use fences to hang bags and equipment.
- \* Respect 6 ft boundaries as prudently as possible.
- \* Coaches: Access to bullpen and storage/equipment rooms will be limited. Please plan to have what you need with you before practices.
- \* All games and practices will be dependent on viral activity in Beltrami county. At any time this summer, the board feels it is unsafe to continue gathering, they will scale back or shut down practices/games, regardless of local/state determinations.
